NEW Pier Progress

Good news! Construction begins in June! Initially, all the activity is underwater, driving piles - the hidden essential support structures for the new pier.

By fall, over water construction gets underway.

Lots of important progress keeps development of the new Pier moving forward. City Council approved an agreement with Colliers International to manage the Pier District, including operations, leasing, marketing and maintenance, and secure restaurants, retailers and other vendors for the Pier.

Council approved a \$75,000 agreement between the City and world-renowned artist, Janet Echelman to provide a feasibility study for the installation of one of her unique, colorful, aerial sculptures at the Pier.

City Council approved recommending a change in the Interlocal Agreement with the County allowing up to \$10 million in existing budget to be applied to Pier District, and up to \$4 million for transportation and parking which can be used downtown.

This fall, overwater construction begins for the Pier, along with the completion of construction documents and permitting for the Pier Approach. Construction for the Pier District is scheduled to be complete by end of 2018.

This week, the City of St. Petersburg reached two important milestones towards construction of the new St. Pete Pier. The final permit was received from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to begin construction; and the Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) for the first phase of construction was approved by City Council.

This was the final permit the City needed before construction can begin.

Said Mayor Rick Kriseman: "The 'New St. Pete Pier' will be a dynamic extension of our iconic waterfront park system, and is sure to be enjoyed by residents and visitors from throughout the world for generations to come. My thanks to my team, our government partners, and our community for getting us to this point."

Said City Council Chair Darden Rice: "With this permit, the next stage of important work begins on our new St. Petersburg Pier. This is one of many critical steps to ensure the pier is built in a sound way compatible with lessened impacts on the bay. My thanks to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for their diligence and work on this permit. I am excited to see construction begin!"

City Council Member Karl Nurse: "St. Pete has gone through an incredibly long process to build our 4th generation pier. I believe our community will be happy with the new pier and uplands."

Initial construction, including driving the pilings that support the Pier structure, and the cast-in-place concrete platform over water, is slated to begin the end of June. Phase 2 of construction, for the work above the Pier platform, will commence in the fall of this year.

Florida's school system spends an average of \$9,585 per student annually, roughly \$2,600 less than the national per-pupil expenditure of \$12,156. Though spending is low, it is relatively **evenly distributed**. The difference in per-pupil spending between highest and lowest spending districts is the **second smallest funding gap of any state**.

Over the past two decades, **Florida implemented significant education reform**. What followed were some of the **best improvements in test scores in the country**. Between 2003 and 2015, reading test results among fourth graders increased more in Florida than in all but two other states. There has also been a dramatic increase in the share of students who take advanced placement classes, as well as in the proportion of students scoring well on advanced placement exams. **Today, both are among the highest such percentages in the nation.**

The Florida Sheriffs Association suggests individuals who receive telephone solicitations use the following precautions:



- Don't act immediately. You are entitled to request and receive information about the charity in writing before donating.
- Verify the charitable organization is registered with the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services by calling (800) 435-7352 or visiting www.800helpfla.com to obtain a copy of registration documents and a financial statement.
- File complaints about possible fraud by contacting the Florida Office of the Attorney General at (866) 966-7226 or www.myfloridalegal.com.
- Reduce unwanted sales calls by registering a phone number with the National Do Not Call Registry by calling (888) 382-1222 or visiting www.donotcall.gov.


